Rifle Match Date: Saturday, October 15th and Sunday, October 16th, 2016

Location: Alliance Rifle Club, Alliance Rd NW & Maple St NM, Malvern OH 44644

Eligibility: This match is open to all qualified shooters 14 years or older. Military personal may enter if they comply with applicable regulations. Membership in the NRA or a CMP affiliated club is not required.

Entries: Entries can be made in person on match weekend. Participants will sign a CMP eligibility affidavit and liability agreement along with an ARC club liability release. In the event there are less than 6 non-distinguished shooters entered, the event will NOT be conducted. In this event, all fees would be returned.

Range capacity: Range capacity for this Rifle Excellence in Competition (EIC) match is 48 shooters, with priority going to Non-Distinguished Shooters.

Time to arrive: Front gate will be open at 7:00 AM. Arrive no later than 8:30 AM.

Registration, squadding, and rifle inspection: Will take place from 7:30 to 8:30 AM at the building at the 300 yard line parking lot, with any final adjustments to be made on the firing line. Squadding will be first come, first serve. Four relays are planned. A competitor who fails to present himself when his relay is called, or fails to show in the pits before they seal, may lose his right to compete in this event.

Time of Firing: Pits will seal at 8:55 am. Firing will begin at 9:00 am.

Rules: In accordance with the current CMP 2016 Competition Rulebook, all CMP EIC matches will be governed by CMP rules. Empty chamber indicators are required.

Fees: Weekend fee (shooting both days): \$50.00; Daily fee: \$30.00

Rifles Allowed: "Service Rifle" as defined in the Current Edition of the CMP Service Rulebook, Rule 6.1

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each unsuccessful challenge made.

Food: Competitors are responsible for their own food. There will be no break during the match for lunch.

Awards: Gold, Silver & Bronze Achievement Pins will be presented to competitors (Distinguished or Non-Distinguished) in CMP-Sanctioned EIC Matches, that equal or exceed Achievement Award Scores. Points are given to any non-distinguished shooters who place in the top ten percent of non-distinguished shooters, provided that the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score (Rule, 9.2.7). Calculations are based on rule 9.2.6. All Points are issued by the CMP. To receive EIC credit points,

the score fired by the competitor must fulfill the requirements of Rule 9.2.6 (top 10%) and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) for that discipline (see CMP Rule 9.2.7). The MCS score for 2016 is 455.

Ammunition: Competitors must supply their own safe ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is permitted.

Sights: Per current CMP rules.

Course of Fire: Civilian Marksmanship Program Rifle Excellence in Competition Match, Rule 8.10.1, the Rifle National Match Course, consisting of the 50 shot National Match Course of Fire (see rule 8.4.1 Table 7, page 54).
