### **M1 for Vets Benefit GSVMM Match:**

**Time to Arrive:** Front gate will be open from **7:30 to 8:30 AM**

**Time of Firing:** Firing will begin at **9:00 AM** from the 200-yard line

**Fees:** \$20 per shooter, \$10 for juniors. All entry fees will be donated by Solon Sportsmen to the M1 for Vets organization.

### **Vintage Sniper Match:**

**Time to Arrive:** Front gate will be open from **11:00AM to Noon**, if you are not already present for the M1 for Vets Match

**Time of Firing:** Firing will begin at **12:30 PM** from the 300-yard line.

**Fees:** \$10 for Solon Sportsmen Association Members, Non-members \$25 per Adult, Juniors are \$10

Two relays and Shotmarkers are planned for each match. Entry fees are separate and not combined as the M1 for Vets GSVMM is a benefit match.

All competitors competing in both matches are requested to complete registration for both matches first thing in the morning.

## **CMP As-Issued Military Rifle Match to Benefit M1 For Vets** **Sunday September 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025**

**Location:** SSA club grounds. 5426 Footville-Richmond Rd. Richmond Township, OH 44003

**Directions:** I-90 to SR11 exit 228. SR11 South to SR 307. East on 307 to SR193. North on SR193 to Footville-Richmond Rd. East on Footville-Richmond Rd. to Club. Property is approximately 4 mi. on the right.

**Time to arrive:** Front gate will be open from **7:30 to 8:30 AM**

**Squadding:** Sign up and squadding will take place from **7:30 to 8:30 AM** at the barn inside the front gate, with final adjustments made on the line. Shotmarker electronic targets are planned; however, final determination will be by the match director. If pits are used all competitors must present themselves when their relay is called, and report for his/her duty in the pits before they seal to be scored in this event.

**Time of Firing:** Firing will begin at **9:00 AM** from the 200-yard line.

**Rules:** Current SSA & CMP Competition Rules will apply.

**Eligibility:** Participants will sign a CMP eligibility affidavit and liability agreement as well as a SSA hold harmless agreement. All rifles shall have a known 200 yard zero.

**Fees:** \$20 per shooter, \$10 for juniors. All entry fees will be donated by Solon Sportsmen to the M1 for Vets organization.

**Rifles Allowed:** As-Issued US M1 Garand, US M1 Carbine, M1941 Johnson, US 1903 & A3 Springfield, US 1917, US Krag, and manually operated foreign military rifles. Modern Military Rifles as defined by the CMP.

**Awards:** Gold, Silver or Bronze Achievement Pins per current CMP cut scores

**Ammunition:** Competitors must supply their own ammunition. No incendiary, AP or tracer ammo is permitted.

**Course of Fire:** As-Issued Military Rifle Match A

**Stage 1:** Slow Fire prone – 5 sighters and 10 shots for record in a time limit of 15 minutes.

**Stage 2:** Rapid fire – standing to prone - 10 shots for record in a time limit of 80 seconds.

**Stage 3:** Slow fire standing – 10 shots for record in a time limit of 10 minutes.

## CMP Vintage and Replica Military Sniper Rifle Team Match Sunday September 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025

**Location:** SSA club grounds. 5426 Footville-Richmond Rd. Richmond Township, OH 44003

**Directions:** I-90 to SR11 exit 228. SR11 South to SR 307. East on 307 to SR193. North on SR193 to Footville-Richmond Rd. East on Footville-Richmond Rd. to Club. Property is approximately 4 mi. on the right.

**Time to arrive:** Front gate will be open from **11:00AM to Noon**

**Squadding:** Sign up and squadding will take place from **11:00AM to Noon** at the barn inside the front gate, with final adjustments made on the line. Two relays are planned. Shotmarker electronic targets are planned; however, final determination will be by the match director. If pits are used all competitors must present themselves when their relay is called, and report for his/her duty in the pits before they seal to be scored in this event.

**Time of Firing:** Firing will begin at **12:30 PM** from the 300-yard line.

**Entries at the match:** Yes, Preregistration is requested, entry at gate may be limited.

**Rules:** Current SSA & CMP Competition Rules will apply.

**Eligibility:** Participants will sign a CMP eligibility affidavit and liability agreement as well as a SSA hold harmless agreement. All rifles shall have a known 200 yard zero. (Note 1)

**Fees:** \$10 for Solon Sportsmen Association Members, Non-members \$25 per Adult, Juniors are \$10

**Rifles Allowed:** The rifle must be a manually operated or semi-automatic rifle of U. S. or foreign manufacture that is either an original military rifle issued for sniping in 1976 or earlier or a commercial replica rifle of the same type and caliber. Tables 8 and 9 of CMP Games Rules. Other rifles will be permitted; however, they will be recorded as out-of-competition and not eligible for achievement pins. The use of compensators, suppressors, or muzzle brakes is prohibited.

**Awards:** Gold, Silver or Bronze Achievement Pins per current CMP cut scores

**Ammunition:** Competitors must supply their own ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is permitted. No caliber larger than 8 MM. A total of 40 shots for record in the match, for the team not counting sighters

**Sights:** Optical or metallic. In competition optics must comply with CMP rules as per Vintage and Replica Sniper list of approved rifles.

**Course of Fire:** As-Issued Military Sniper Rifle Match

**Stage 1:** Slow Fire prone – Unlimited sighters in five minutes. (Note 2) and 10 shots at 300 yards for record Slow fire, single loaded, in a time limit determined from target operation in the pits. Second team shooter fires 10 shots at 300 yards, directly after the first shooter, in same single shot format.

**Stage 2:** Slow Fire prone – Unlimited sighters in five minutes. (Note 2) and 10 shots at 600 yards for record Slow fire, single loaded, in a time limit determined from target operation in the pits. Second team shooter fires 10 shots at 600 yards, directly after the first shooter, in same single shot format.

**Note 1:** If your rifle does not have a known 200 yard zero, you must notify the line officer before firing.

**Note 2:** Sighting shots will be taken from the prone position. Sandbags will not be provided and the team will provide a front sand bag or bean bag. No adjustable rifle stands will be allowed. If shooter desires a military sling of 1.25 inches or less may be used instead of a sandbag, but only one may be used. Out-of-Competition rifles may use bipods.
