Rifle Matches

Dates: Saturday, September 19th and
Sunday, September 20th, 2026

Location: SSA club grounds. 5426 Footville-
Richmond Rd. Richmond Township, OH 44003

Directions: I-90 to SR11 exit 228.
SR11 South to SR 307. East on 307 to SR193.
North on SR193 to Footville-Richmond Rd.
East on Footville-Richmond Rd. to Club
Property is approximately 4 mi. on the right.

Lodging: Search around Austinburg or Ashtabula,
Ohio for listing of area hotels.

Eligibility: This match is open to all qualified
shooters 12 years or older. Military personnel may
enter if they comply with applicable regulations.

Entries: Entries can be made in person on match
weekend. Participants will sign a CMP eligibility
affidavit and liability agreement along with an SSA
hold harmless agreement.

In the event there are less than 6 non-distinguished
shooters entered, the event will be cancelled. In this
event all fees would be returned.

Range capacity: Range capacity for this Rifle
Excellence in Competition (EIC) match is 56
shooters, with priority going to Non-Distinguished
Shooters.

Time to arrive: Front gate will be open at
7:00 AM. Arrive no later than 8:30 AM.

Registration, squadding, and rifle inspection:
Will take place from 7:00 to 8:30 AM at the building
at club's front gate, with any final adjustments will be
made on the firing line. Squadding will be first come,
first serve, with priority going to non-distinguished
competitors. Four relays are planned. Shotmarker
electronic targets are planned; however, final
determination will be by the match director. If pits are
used all competitors must present themselves when
their relay is called and report for his/her duty in the
pits before they seal to be scored in this event.

Time of Firing: Pits will seal at 8:55 AM. Firing will
begin at 9:00 AM.

Fees: \$40.00 Adults & \$25 Juniors each match

Rifles Allowed: Service Rifle and Alternative Rifle,
Match Rifles are allowed but not eligible for EIC
points. RSVP with any questions.

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$3.00 will be
charged for each unsuccessful challenge made.

Food: There will be no break during the match for
lunch. There will be planned picnic after the Saturday
match, a \$5 donation for the picnic would be
appreciated.

Awards: Achievement Pins will be presented at the
match. All scores will be submitted to CMP for
Excellence-In-Competition awards schedule.

Ammunition: Competitors must supply their own
safe ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is
permitted.

Course of Fire: Civilian Marksmanship Program
Rifle Excellence in Competition Match. The Rifle
National Match Course, consisting of 50 shots (no
sighting shots) per CMP competition rules.
